A IS FOR AN AVIATRIX, SERVED SHORT WITH NO ICE. GIN, LEMON, MARASCHINO, AQUAFABA AND SKY BLUE VIOLET




B IS FOR A BRANDY PUNCH, JERRY THOMAS' FIRST DRINK, SERVED SHORT WITH RASPBERRY, LEMON AND COGNAC




C IS FOR A COFFEE COCKTAIL, ANOTHER BON VIVANT CLASSIC, BEST SERVED AFTER DINNER, COGNAC, PORT, SPICES AND AN EGG SERVED SHORT




D IS FOR A DAIQUIRI, FROM A SMALL TOWN IN SOUTHERN CUBA, WHITE RUM, LIME JUICE AND A LITTLE SWEET SERVED SHORT




E IS FOR AN EAST INDIA COCKTAIL, COURTESY OF HARRY JOHNSON 1882. RASPBERRY, COGNAC, MARASCHINO AND AQUAFABA SERVED SHORT




F IS FOR A FRENCH 75, NAMED AFTER THE BIG GUNS, AT SANK ROO DOE NOO. GIN, LEMON, SWEET AND CHAMPAGNE IN A FLUTE




G IS FOR A GEORGIA MINT JULEP, THE PERFECT SOUTHERN DRINK, FRESH MINT, COGNAC AND PEACH BRANDY SERVED TALL AND BUSHY




H IS FOR A HAVE A HEART, FROM P G DUFFY IN '34. FAR REACHES GIN, SWEDISH PUNSCH, FRESH LIME AND POMEGRANATE, SERVED SHORT AND ROSY



I IS FOR AN INCOME TAX COCKTAIL. GIN AND VERMOUTH, BOTH WHITE AND RED, ANGOSTURA AND FRESH ORANGE IN A COUPETTE




J IS FOR A JACKIE ROSE, OUR TWIST ON EMBURY'S FAV, APPLEJACK, AQUAFABA, LEMON AND GRENADINE SERVED SHORT




K IS FOR THE KNICKERBOCKER COCKTAIL, NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH A KNICKERBOCKER, THIS IS OUR MARTINI WITH A TOUCH OF ANTICA FORMULA




L IS FOR A LAST WORD, I LIKE TO THINK THIS IS WHAT GATSBY USED HIS CHARTREUSE FOR. WITH FRESH LIME, GIN AND MARASCHINO SERVED SHORT



M IS FOR A MANHATTAN, MADE THE WAY THE ONLY WILLIAM DID, MARASCHINO, RYE, ANGOSTURA, ABSINTHE AND ITALIAN VERMOUTH WITH AN AMARENA CHERRY




N IS FOR A NEGRONI, THE COUNTS FAVOURITE DRINK, CAMPARI, VERMOUTH MADE THE WAY PAPA TAUGHT ME IN '98, EXTRA GIN. ALWAYS EXTRA GIN. SHORT OVER A GIANT CUBE OF ICE



O IS FOR AN OLD FASHIONED, THE ORIGINAL COCKTAIL. BOURBON, BITTERS AND A BIG ORANGE ZEST SERVED SHORT OVER A GIANT CUBE




P IS FOR A PISCO SOUR, FROM A PROHIBITION FLEEING VICTOR. PISCO, LEMON, SUGAR FREE SUGAR, BITTERS AND AQUAFABA, AND A DUSTING OF NUTMEG SERVED SHORT




Q IS FOR A QUEENS, NAMED AFTER HER MAJESTY NOT THE BOROUGH. GIN, WHITE AND RED VERMOUTH, AND THOROUGHLY BRITISH PINEAPPLE SERVED SHORT



R IS FOR A ROYAL BERMUDA YACHT CLUB, GOSLING'S RUM, LIME, COINTREAU AND FALERNUM SERVED SHORT




S IS FOR A SIDECAR, ANOTHER EMBURY CLASSIC, COGNAC, COINTREAU, SWEET AND LEMON SERVED SHORT




T IS FOR A TOM COLLINS, OUR IMPERIAL FIZZ VERSION, WITH EARL GREY INFUSED GIN, LEMON, SODA AND MADEIRA SERVED TALL




U IS FOR AN UP TO DATE COCKTAIL, RYE, GRAND MARNIER, OLOROSO SHERRY AND BITTERS OVER A GIANT ICE CUBE




V IS FOR A VIEUX CARRE, THE NEW ORLEANS CLASSIC, RYE, COGNAC, RED VERMOUTH, BENEDICTINE AND BITTERS SERVED SHORT




W IS FOR A WHITE LADY, ANOTHER FROM HARRY'S IN PARIS, GIN, LEMON, COINTREAU AND SWEET SERVED SHORT
